

Punjab Government for Development of Industry in the State



Led by Revenue, Information and Public Relations Minister Bikram Singh Majithia, the party leadership of Ludhiana projected the achievements of the SAD-BJP government for the development of industry in Ludhiana and also tried to provide solutions to their problems.

In a program organized by Chamber of Industrial and Commercial Undertakings (CICU), Majithia asked industrialists to raise their issues directly to him and held an open discussion with them.

In a bid to show seriousness of the event the Revenue Minister had specially called all top level district administrative officials of various departments to have their views over the issues raised by the industrialists.

However, the industrialists challenged a few reasons given by the Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. over certain conditions imposed to levy transformers for small industries. Over the issue of making special clusters for different kind of industries, the Revenue Minister said due to tough new land acquisition law brought in recently, it had become very difficult to acquire land for any kind of developmental project.

He exhorted the industrialists to directly approach the Chief Minister, Deputy Chief Minister or any Minister concerned in case of any problem faced by them.

"However, for Ludhiana, the Deputy Commissioner has already been instructed to overview the provisions of land in the district for the cluster," he claimed. Majithia said the SAD-BJP government had fulfilled its promise to provide world-class infrastructure by making the state power surplus, setting up of two international and five domestic airports, linking every city and town of the state with four or six lane highways, besides implementing a new investor friendly industrial policy.
